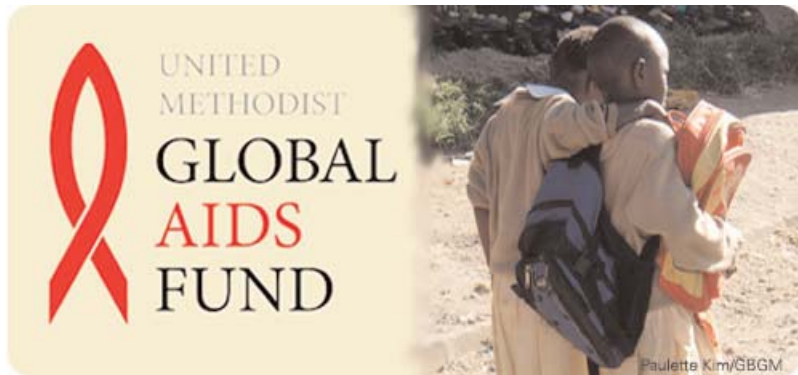


2008 ANNUAL CONFERENCE MISSION OFFERING

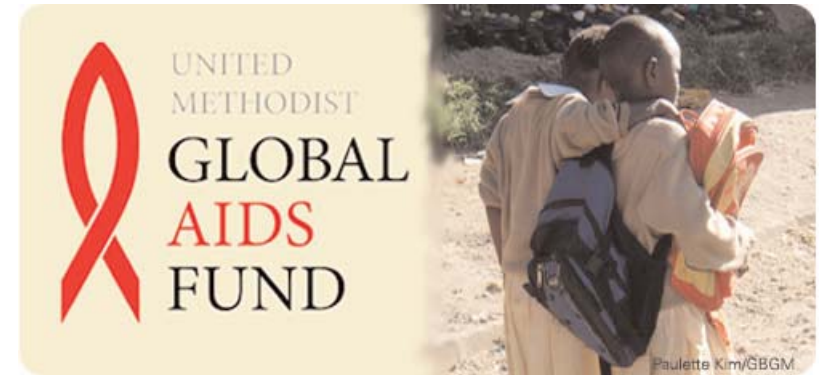
